Postscript

The long \int is a typographic oddity of which I there is infufficient awareness. Take notice that f and f, & f and f, are two distinct typographic glyphs, each with its own unique features. Please observe that the long s does not have a full horizontal crossbar, whereas the f does. It is how the "S" found is written when in a lower case, and when not at the end of a word. Apologies if this has caused confusion.
